

Individuals who have NOT received a questionnaire the Census Bureau has provided a few options.

- Contact the Muskegon Local Census Office (LCO) @ 231-683-2340. The LCO will ask the caller for specific information regarding the location of the housing unit and we will perform the necessary research to identify why this individual did not receive a questionnaire and make sure they are counted in the Census.
- Contact the Detroit Regional Census Center @ 313-396-5200. The Regional Census Center will ask the caller for specific information regarding the location of the housing unit and we will perform the necessary research to identify why this individual did not receive a questionnaire and make sure they are counted in the Census.
- Go to a local Questionnaire Assistance/Be Counted Center to obtain a 'Be Counted' questionnaire. A 'Be Counted' questionnaire allows the individual to put down a full description of their address, and then contains the same 10 questions as the other Census form. To find a local Questionnaire Assistance Center/Be Counted Center in your area access the 'Take 10 Questionnaire Assistance Center' website.
